This Cookie Policy ("Policy") is valid for websites managed by our Practice ("CLIENT"), and cookies will be used as described in this Policy during your visit to our website.

Your Personal Data, your privacy are important to us, your privacy and security rights are our basic principle. In order to protect the confidentiality of the personal information of our Web Site visitors, our Customers, in short, the necessary precautions have been taken by keeping the system and internet infrastructure of our practice at the most reliable level.

You can visit our website without providing any personal information, and you can meet your needs by getting information about our products and services. Cookies are used to collect information about site usage during visits. Our aim here; to provide convenience to the user visiting our website and to understand how we can improve the operation.

A cookie is a small file containing a string of characters that is sent to your computer when you visit a website. Cookies aim to make a website more user-friendly. It enables personalized web pages to be offered in order to provide a more convenient and faster visiting experience for your personal needs. Cookies cannot collect any information, including your personal data stored on your computer, mobile device or files. There are two types of cookies, Persistent Cookie and Temporary Cookie, according to their validity period. Temporary cookies are created while visiting the website and are only valid until you close your browser. Persistent cookies are created when you visit our website and remain until you delete them or they expire.

Our website uses temporary and permanent type cookies to distinguish you from other users of our website and to make arrangements according to your interests and preferences. In addition to cookies designed by our practice, cookies can also be used within the scope of services received from third parties.

Almost all internet browsers are predefined to accept cookies automatically.

However, you can control or delete cookies as you wish. Since managing cookies differs from browser to browser, you can refer to the browser's help menu for detailed information.

What is a cookie?

A cookie is a small text file that the site saves on your computer or mobile device when you visit a site. Cookies are widely used to make a website work or operate more efficiently or to provide information to website owners.

How do we use which Cookies?

Cookies installed on your computer or mobile device or the information obtained are used for statistical analysis or security measures. Any of your personal data is not collected through cookies.

What Are the Types of Cookies?

Cookie Type Description

Session Cookies Session cookies are cookies that are valid during your use of the website and remain valid until the web browser is closed.

Persistent Cookies These are cookies that are stored in your browser and remain valid until they are deleted by you or until their expiration date.

Compulsory Cookies These are the cookies that are mandatory for the website to function properly and for you to benefit from the features of the site and the services offered.

Functional and Analytical

Cookies

These are cookies that are used for purposes such as remembering your preferences, using the website effectively, optimizing the site to respond to your requests, and containing data about how you use the site. Due to their nature, these types of cookies may contain your personal data. For example, cookies that save your site's display language preference are functional cookies.

Tracking Cookies

Tracking cookies are primary and third-party cookies created during your visit to our website and third-party domains. These cookies make it possible to track your click and visit history in the domains where they were created, and to match these records between different domains. These types of cookies are used for the purpose of recognizing and profiling users , targeting advertising and marketing activities and customizing the content. These cookies will not be used to identify you or to make decisions for you personally.

How can you control cookies?

You can control or delete cookies as you wish. You can delete cookies already on your computer or mobile device and prevent the saving/setting of cookies in most Internet browsers.

How can you manage cookies in Internet explorer?

Most Internet browsers allow you to:

- View and delete saved cookies
- Blocking third-party cookies
- Blocking cookies from certain sites
- Block all cookies
- Deleting all cookies when you close the Internet browser

If you choose to delete cookies, your preferences on the relevant website will be deleted. Also, if you choose to block cookies altogether, many websites, including our Practice websites, may not work properly.
